# EARLY ASSURANCE VS. TWO-YEAR PATHWAY

## Early Assurance

## 2 Years + PharmD

### SCHOLARSHIPS

Access to highest available offerings; continuation of undergraduate merit scholarships

Continuation of undergraduate merit scholarships

### ACADEMIC ELIGIBILITY

Must enter as a freshman with a minimum Math ACT score  $\geq 24$  or Math SAT  $\geq 560$  to complete General Chemistry I in first semester

No specific eligibility, but may require summer enrollment to remain on track

### INTERVIEW ELIGIBILITY

Guaranteed for students with a 3.3 GPA or higher and are on track to complete all prerequisites by the end of the second year

Highly preferred for students with a 3.3 GPA or higher who are on track to complete all prerequisites by the end of the second year

### TRANSFER OF OUTSIDE PREREQUISITES

Non-math and science courses only\*
