

## **Policies and Registration Procedures for *Linked Cohort Courses (LCCs)***

- ❖ **When you have successfully completed the First-Year Seminar (FYS), you will then take one set of LCCs.**
- ❖ **If you fail the FYS, you must drop the LCCs and re-take the FYS instead.** (You may not take these simultaneously.)
- ❖ **All LCCs are listed at the LCC link in the green “BELL Core” box—to the right of the main menu for ClassFinder.**
- ❖ **Please note the two LCCs that include MTH 1020 are reserved for students whose skills are not strong in Mathematics.** NOTE: If your Math ACT score was 28+, your Math SAT score was 630+, or your Math Placement Test score was 28+, you may not enroll in this LCC—and if you do, you will be asked and expected to drop this LCC. If your scores were (ACT) 25+, (SAT) 570+, or (Placement) 24+, the Math Department recommends strongly that you avoid this LCC, as well, and instead take MTH 1080 (which is not offered as an LCC) to meet your Gen. Ed. requirement in Math.
- ❖ ***The exact same set of students must be enrolled in both halves of the LCC; you must co-enroll in both courses.*** BannerWeb will allow you to register for one of these LCC courses only if you are simultaneously registering for the other one.
- ❖ **Once you are enrolled in an LCC, you may not drop one of the linked courses without dropping the other.** You must communicate with your LCC faculty members if you are faltering in their courses; they may initiate contact with you as well. The goal is to ensure that you successfully complete the LCC experience.
- ❖ ***In order to receive credit for the LCC requirement, you must pass both of the courses.*** If you fail one or both of the courses, you will not receive credit for the “linkage” requirement and will have to pass both courses of another LCC. The new LCC may include the failed course(s) or may be comprised of two entirely different BELL Core courses.
