* HUM 1210, which is currently a 6-hour course (as is HON 1210), will become a 3-hour course, while HON 1210 will be a 4-hour course, which means that the 4th hour will become an elective credit hour in the BELL Core. These two courses will never be cross-listed, as such, in ClassFinder; rather, HUM 1210 is a way to give students credit for their Honors seminar—and also to offer a course in Classics.
