



Audition Requirements – Musical Theatre

- **Vocal & Monologue Audition:**

- Perform one aria or art song (one minute or less) with live accompaniment.
- Perform two musical theatre songs of contrasting style; each piece cut to one minute or less. Live accompaniment required.
- Perform a one-minute memorized age-appropriate monologue from a musical or theatre production.
- Accompanists are provided by the School of Music. Bring music in the proper key because they will not transpose or improvise.

NOTE:

- Songs and monologue must be memorized.
 - No original songs permitted.
 - Students must use an accompanist for all three songs.
 - Students may not accompany themselves for the audition.
 - Feel free to move during your musical theatre songs; however, dancing during your songs is not recommended
- **Dance Audition**
 - Perform a 1-minute choreographed solo dance in tap, ballet, jazz or modern style (no hip-hop or show choir choreography, please). A CD player will be provided.
 - **Following the solo dance auditions, a 90 minute group dance class** will be conducted by dance faculty; audition will include ballet, tap and jazz.
 - Please bring appropriate dance attire.

Materials to Bring

- Music in the proper key for your classical piece and musical theatre cuts. Accompanists will not be asked to transpose or improvise.
- One copy of a repertory list which includes all solo literature studied by the student to be presented to the evaluators at the time of the audition.
- One copy of a music activities list to present to the evaluators at the time of the audition.
- Any materials noted in your principal performing area audition requirements.
- Headshot (cut to 8"x10") and resume.
