Specific Audition Time for Each Applicant - Times are pre-assigned late Friday after we have a firm list of who is attending. Each individual student will receive their specific audition time when they register on Saturday morning at 8:00 a.m.

As noted in the “Getting Started in the School of Music” link, all auditioning students will have received an e-mail shortly after they apply to the University and complete the School of Music Supplement.

This e-mail from the School of Music Admissions Office confirms their audition day request, requests a return e-mail to verify their major and principal and includes further instructions and information about audition day.

The e-mail is sent to the e-mail address provided by the applicant on the School of Music Supplement . . . no hard-copy snail mail confirmations are sent to the student.
