

Procedure for Applying to CampusFrance

***The cost of CampusFrance is: \$60 for study abroad students The visa application fee for students has now been lowered to about \$60 (for more information go to the French Consulate of your region's website). Please **send a money order with your name printed on it** when you send the required documents to CampusFrance.

- 1. Fill out the on-line CampusFrance application found on the home page.** Find the box at the right that says "My Campus France" and click the link called "Registration".
- 2. Once you have started the application you will have a 'login' and a 'password'. Please try not to misplace these.** If you do, contact campusfrance@ambafrance-us.org . With your login, you will not only have access to your application, but to a 'mailbox'. With your CampusFrance mailbox, you can correspond directly with CampusFrance USA and the visa department of your region.
- 3. You with a Letter of Acceptance (sent from the Université d'Angers). Once you have received the letter send a copy to CampusFrance (either by e-mail, fax, or post.).**
- 4. Put together the documents required by CampusFrance and the application fees. Send them directly to CampusFrance.** It is highly recommended that you send everything in one envelope, by traceable delivery (USPS Express Mail, FedEx, or UPS.)

Once CampusFrance has received your necessary documents, they will scan them and add them to your application. At this point your application is complete.

- 5. CampusFrance will schedule an interview** by web cam or telephone. In some cases, an interview will not be required. If this is the case, CampusFrance will let you know.
- 6. Apply for your visa.** Once you have finished your CampusFrance application, you can start the visa application process. Please remember: the granting of visas is the sole responsibility of the Consulate of France. <http://www.ambafrance-us.org/intheus/consulates.asp>
