Criteria:

- Be enrolled as a University College student (ACC, LIS, MIN, PBBA, PRM, RN-BSN majors)
- Be enrolled in a full time or part time program in the semester of the award
- Balance roles and responsibilities associated with being an adult learner
- NEW nominee for the award (not previously considered)

Nominees should also demonstrate the following characteristics:

- Learn with infectious enthusiasm
- Demonstrate a commitment to his/her program of study
- Support and encourage other learners to engage in learning activities
- Be willing to share new skills, knowledge and abilities with others
- Challenge him/herself and others with new ideas

Nominations can be made on the recommendation of faculty, students, or staff. There is no limitation on the number of nominations faculty, students, and staff can put forward. Nominations forms will be completed in no more than 600 words detailing the way in which the nominee meets the criteria.

Please submit your Belmont Adult Student Recognition Award nomination based on the four questions below

1. What is unique about this nontraditional student?
2. What is outstanding about this student's performance?
3. What challenges has this student successfully met as a "adult" student while attending Belmont?
4. Give examples of how this student serves as a role model for his/her classmates, instructors, coworkers, or family.
