Please be advised that Belmont University offers nonstandard/accelerated (5 weeks, 8 weeks and 10 weeks) courses each semester and three summer sessions. The timing of these course offerings may affect the enrollment status and vary the benefit amount to recipients.

- <u>Undergraduate</u>: full time enrollment constitutes 12 hours (full term courses); 6 hours (eight week courses); 7 hours (ten week summer session); 4 hours (five week summer sessions)
- <u>Graduate:</u> full time enrollment is 6 hours (full term courses); 3 hours (eight week courses); 4 hours (ten week courses); 2 hours (five week courses)

If you choose <u>not</u> to use your VA Education Benefit for a semester, you must inform the VA School Certifying Official of your decision in advance of the registration if possible. DVA does limit the ability of School Certifying Officials to terminate enrollment certifications.

Changes in course enrollment after the university's drop and add period may result in a *retroactive loss of monetary benefits* unless the Department of Veteran Affairs grants mitigating circumstances. DVA does not pay for non-punitive grades (i.e. W, WP or AU). If a final grade of `FN' is assigned for non-attendance, you will be liable to repay benefits to the DVA effective the last date of attendance in the course. If a punitive final grade of `WF' is assigned, you may also be liable to repay benefits to the DVA effective the last date of attendance in the course.
