Admissions Timeline

Exact dates will be finalized with each specific high school and announced to candidates by their high school guidance counselor.

OCTOBER

Counselors Summit

A virtual event will be offered to school counselors to outline scholarship program guidelines and to overview the recruitment timeline and selection processes.

Candidate Interest Submission

Each candidate must meet with their counselor to submit an interest form for the Bridges to Belmont scholarship program. The interest submission should consist of name and official transcripts. Completion of this component grants access to the Candidate Portal.

Academic Supplement Submission

Applicants will have up to 6 weeks to submit supplemental academic materials to accompany traditional application checklist items.

Virtual Open House (October 26)

An online information session will be hosted by Belmont University to learn more about the scholarship program, application process and timeline. Parents are also encouraged to participate. (Virtual invitation, registration and access instructions to follow.)

NOVEMBER 15

Application Submission

Eligible students must submit the application for 2022 Undergraduate Admission, consisting of a completed essay and resume of activities. Counselors must submit official high school transcripts, ACT/SAT test scores (optional) and guidance counselor (or principal) recommendations. Contact School Counselor for application instructions and fee waiver.

JANUARY

Interview Day

Selected candidates with submitted applications will be invited to interview with Scholarship Committee (TBD: Location in-person v. virtual).

FEBRUARY 15

Candidate Day

Nominated students come to Belmont for a campus tour, meet current Bridges to Belmont Scholars, faculty and staff members, and participate in group processing activities with all high schools.

MARCH 1

Decision Day

Admission decisions for selected Bridges to Belmont Scholars will be announced, and decision letters will be distributed to each high school.

MARCH 15

Signing Day

The deadline to return signed offer letters to Belmont University to confirm acceptance of the admissions offer.

APRIL

Be Belmont Day & Celebratory Reception

An invitation-only event for all Fall 2022 admitted seniors held at Belmont on Saturday, **April 9, 2022.**

On-Boarding Event

This event, hosted at Belmont, is only for confirmed Bridges to Belmont Scholars to discuss key announcements and action steps.



Candidate Interest Submission:
This component consists of name and unofficial transcripts.
Academic Supplement Submission:
Candidates must submit a 500-word personal essay exploring five ways of being.
Degree-seeking Application
Official ACT/SAT test score (minimum ACT: 20 composite score)
Test Optional for 2022 entry term
Official High School Transcript (minimum GPA: 3.00 weighted GPA)
School Counselor or HS Principal Recommendation
Resume of Activities
