Graduate Opportunities in Leadership Development

Mission: The Belmont Office of Leadership Development's **GOLD** Experiences are customizable leadership development opportunities designed for working professionals or full time graduate students who have a desire to enhance their capacity to lead and serve ethically.

Values: There are 3 values (**Service, Experience** and **Ethics**) and 4 GOLD levels of engagement (Belonging, Believing, Becoming, Being with 30 credits/hours) to be completed to earn the GOLD leadership certificate.

Time Commitment: GOLD is a 1-2 year leadership development experience that is accessible for all Belmont graduate students. Students will earn credit for their leadership development experiences related to ethics, resilience, collaboration, communication, inclusivity and ethics.

This reflection should include what has been discovered and how it will impact the world. Both students may submit one 2-page paper for the experience.
