



2025-2026 Architecture Student Cost Breakdown

Below are program-specific items and estimated costs to the student in addition to the University's financial calculator.

It is our general policy to provide basic tools and supplies needed for instruction within our departmental budget line. This includes some supplies for students such as plotter ink and paper for large format printing, along with other media available for use in-class. Student provide supplies and materials used for their individual projects based on assignment parameters and personal preference.

Laptop Computer \$1,600-\$2,400 to meet software requirements*

From the second year onward, students will be working with advanced software for design, modeling, and rendering that requires more powerful laptops. Having the right machine ensures smoother performance, fewer delays, and the ability to handle complex studio projects with confidence.

We recommend a laptop running Windows 11 (64-bit), with at least an Intel Core i7/i9 or AMD Ryzen 7/9 processor at 2.5GHz or faster, 32 GB of RAM, and a dedicated graphics card such as the NVIDIA RTX 4060 (or higher) with 8 GB VRAM or the AMD equivalent. A 1 TB SSD or larger provides enough storage, while a 15-inch or larger screen with 1920x1080 resolution makes design work more comfortable. Wi-Fi, an integrated webcam and microphone, and a three-button mouse are also important.

All costs below are estimates **per semester** in addition to the University costs.
