



Below are program-specific items and estimated costs to the student in addition to the University's financial calculator.

It is our general policy to provide basic tools and supplies needed for instruction within our departmental budget line. This includes some supplies for students such as plotter ink and paper for large format printing, along with other media available for use in-class. Students provide supplies and materials used for their individual projects based on assignment parameters and personal preference.

Laptop Computer

Price Range \$1,200 - \$1,700

A basic laptop with internet connectivity and standard office document processing and PowerPoint or similar presentation option is suggested for the first semester for assignments completed outside of class. By the second semester, students begin their technical education using software that is image-rich, requiring computers capable of processing and housing large-format files. We recommend a minimum of 32 GB RAM with a graphics card ("gaming" laptop) and an external hard drive for additional storage.
