2. Elective Requirements - 6 Hours

Each student in the program is required to take 6 elective hours (2 courses) beyond the MSAA core. Students may elect to follow a general MSAA track, selecting 6 hours of electives that are of interest or enhance their knowledge in more than one area. Alternatively, students may designate an area of specialization that provides a marketable documentation of concentrated academic work. Elective tracks allow each student to “customize” their MSAA program of study. Current elective tracks include Accounting, Business Systems & Analytics, Entrepreneurship, Finance, Health Care Management, and Music Business. Additional tracks may be added as determined by student interest.
